CalABLE is a savings and investment plan offered by the state of California to individuals who developed a disability by age 26. Eligible individuals, family, friends, and employers can contribute up to \$19,000 per year, and up to \$100,000 total, without affecting eligibility for public disability benefits like SSI. Best of all, earnings on qualified withdrawals are federal and California state tax-free.



The program embraces that adults have a right to an age-appropriate education, independence, community inclusion, respect, and personal choice.

Classes focus on functional academics (basic math, reading, writing, money and time concepts), community independence (use of public transportation, street safety, shopping skills, etc.), independent living skills, communication skills (including conflict resolution, friendships, and relationships), work readiness (volunteer work experience, job training, career exploration, work goals), basic computer literacy, health for everyday living, and leisure time skills.

Each year, students choose classes within the program according to their goals and preferences. Classes are held at the adult school (integrated with classes for non-disabled persons) and in natural environments whenever possible (e.g., working and volunteering in the community, traveling on public transportation, food service training in a professional kitchen, etc.), all utilizing age-appropriate materials.
